## Notification of the coronavirus (COVID-19) measures at the Minamiza Theatre

Thank you for supporting the Minamiza Theatre and our theatre productions.

We will provide a safe environment inside our theatres by taking the following measures. We ask all visitors' understanding and cooperation regarding the precautionary measures below which will be implemented at our theatres.

## **Requests for Customer Cooperation**









- •We ask all customers to wear a mask inside the theatre. Admission to the theatre may be denied to those who do not have one due to the potential risk for other customers.
- All audience seats will be sterilized every day.
- $\odot$  Shouts by members of the audience (Õ-mukō) will be prohibited.
- Please refrain from giving gifts or letters or from paying visits to cast members.

**⊙**Customers who are not feeling well are asked not to enter the theatre.

If you are concerned about your health (cough, sore throat, fever, physical weariness etc), please refrain from visiting.

- Please refrain from talking as much as possible during performances and in the lobby.
- We ask customers to eat in silence only in their seats.\*No eating during performances and bringing in alcohols.

## Measures at the theatre

 Seat configuration is subject to change depending on the theatre's countermeasures. Please check our website's theatre information page.

We will temporally suspend all lending of blankets, cushions and opera glasses.

- Hand sanitizers will be installed in theatre lobbies and restrooms, as well as surfaces that are frequently touched by customers in the theatre.
- •We are increasing the physical health checks for our theater staff.

- •Thermography will be installed at the entrance to scan the body temperature of our customers. Customers who are detected to have a high body temperature with a fever of 37.5°C or higher will be asked not to enter the theatre.
- Ventilation and Humidity is properly maintained inside the auditorium. (Ventilation is increased more than usual)
- Social distancing is maintained.

Elevator capacity will be restricted to 4 people.

Additions and changes will be made to the theatre countermeasures if new announcements are made by the government, relevant government agencies and local governments. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.
