Thank you for supporting the Kabukiza Theatre and our theatre productions.

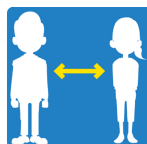
We will provide a safe environment inside our theatres by taking the following measures. We ask all visitors' understanding and cooperation regarding the precautionary measures below which will be implemented at our theatres.

Requests for Customer Cooperation



Wearing a mask is recommended

(Until March 12 th , we ask all customers to wear a mask inside the theatre)



To reduce congestion, please keep your distance from other customers.



Customers with tickets for consecutive parts are asked to leave the theatre once the previous part has ended so that the theatre can be cleaned and sanitized.



Please refrain from talking loudly during performances and in the lobby.



We ask customers to refrain from talking as much as possible when eating in their seats and in the lobby.

*No eating during performances and bringing in alcohols.



Please refrain from paying visits or givings gifts to cast members. Shouts by members of the audience (Ō-mukō) will be prohibited.

◎Following the government's guidelines, from March 13 th , 2023, the wearing of a mask will be at the individual's discretion. However, there may be cases when mask-wearing will be required at the judgement of the business operators.

◎Customers who are not feeling well are asked not to enter the theatre.

◎We may refuse entry to customers who do not follow the theatre staff's instructions, or who cause any nuisance that unreasonably interferes with other customers.

Measures at the theatre

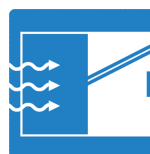


Thermography will be installed at the entrance to scan the body temperature of our customers.

*Customers who are detected to have a high body temperature with a fever of 37.5°C or higher will be asked not to enter the theatre.



Hand sanitizers will be installed in theatre lobbies and restrooms.



Ventilation and Humidity is properly maintained inside the auditorium.



We are increasing the physical health checks for our theater staff.

*All theatre staff will take their temperature every morning and wear a mask, hand gloves, face shields, etc.

◎Tea will not be offered at the Box Seats and Single Act Seats are not for sale.

◎We will temporarily suspend lending of opera glasses.

◎To avoid overcrowding, theatre staffs will guide your leavings in turns.

Additions and changes will be made to the theatre countermeasures if new announcements are made by the government, relevant government agencies and local governments. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.
