## **Requests for Customer Cooperation**



Wearing a mask is recommended (Until March 12 th , we ask all customers to wear a mask inside the theatre)



Customers with tickets for consecutive parts are asked to leave the theatre once the previous part has ended so that the theatre can be cleaned and sanitized.





Please refrain from talking loudly during performances and in the lobby.

Please refrain from paying visits or givings gifts to cast members.



We ask customers to eat only in their seats during intermissions.

Customers who are not feeling well are asked not to enter the theatre.
To avoid overcrowding, theatre staffs will guide your leavings in turns.

## Measures at the theatre



Thermography will be installed at the entrance to scan the body temperature of our customers. \*Customers who are detected to have a high body temperature with a fever of 37.5°C or higher will be asked not to enter the theatre.



Ventilation and Humidity is properly maintained inside the auditorium.



Hand sanitizers will be installed in theatre lobbies and restrooms.



We are increasing the physical health checks for our theater staff.

\*All theatre staff will take their temperature every morning and wear a mask, hand gloves, face shields, etc.
